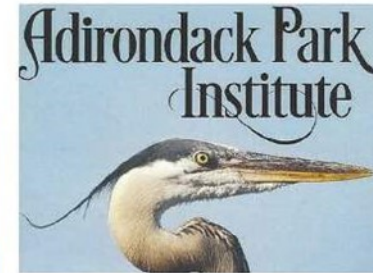

ABOUT THE HUTCHINS AWARD: **Frank McAlister Hutchins** passion for the Adirondacks led him to long standing support and leadership of Paul Smith's College as a trustee for 23 years, and since 1989 to the Visitor's Interpretive Centers and the Adirondack Park Institute, which he was Founding President. The API Trustees created the Frank M. Hutchins Adirondack Environmental Education Leadership Award to honor Frank's memory in recognition of exceptional leadership in Adirondack educational programs and experiences. Since 1994, **Steven Engelhart** has been the Executive Director of Adirondack Architectural Heritage (AARCH), the regional historic preservation organization of the Adirondack Park. AARCH's mission is to promote better public understanding, appreciation and stewardship of the region's built environment. Steven has a BA from SUNY Plattsburgh and has a MS in historic preservation from the University of Vermont. He is the author of *Crossing the River: Historic Bridges of the AuSable River*, speaks frequently about Adirondack architecture and historic preservation throughout the region, and resides in Essex. He is also involved in a number of local and statewide organizations, including on the advisory council of the Preservation League of New York State, and serves on the boards of the Arto Monaco Historical Society and the Bruce Crary Education Foundation.



Neil Woodworth is the Executive Director and Counsel of the Adirondack Mountain Club. He is an environmental lawyer who has served in many official capacities in conservation affairs, including service on the Congressional Northern Forest Lands Council, the Empire State Task Force for Land and Water Conservation Funding, New York Open Space Advisory committee, the New York Forest Preserve Advisory Committee, and the Governor's Task Force on the Adirondack Park Agency. Mr. Woodworth spent ten years as a trial and litigation lawyer before assuming his duties with the Adirondack Mountain Club in 1989 and partnering with New York New Jersey Trail Conference in 1997, the Catskill 3500 Club and Catskill Center for Conservation and Development since 2004. He is a graduate of Hobart College (1975) and Albany Law School of Union University (1978).
